 Technical Advisory/Evaluation committee constituted for the purpose by Board of
 Directors, JKMSCL during 3rd board meeting for the purpose and as per the system

- 2. With reference to clause 2.1.9 Chapter II of the Standard Procurement Procedure approved during 2nd Board Meeting, it was decided by the technical advisory/evaluation committee that the Chairman, Technical Advisory/Evaluation Committee shall get the preliminary evaluation done by the sub-committee and then shall get the minor infirmities asked from the respective bidders, if any by permitting a period of maximum seven days to get the documents/infirmities uploaded.
